ADA SIGNAGE REGULATIONS

TEMPORARY SIGNS: Do not need to conform to ADA guidelines.

PERMANENT SIGNS: Those designating permanent rooms and spaces.

- Characters are to be between 5/8" and 2" in height.
- Must be accompanied by grade 2 Braille.
- Characters to be sans serif or simple serif type and to be all upper case.
- Characters are to be raised a minimum of 1/32".
- Pictograms, when used, are not required to be raised, but may be so.
- Pictograms are to be within their own 6" field.
- Written description should be below the pictogram.
- Characters and background are to be matte or non glare finish and contrast with each other.
- Signs to be mounted to latch side of door and are to be 60" from center line of sign to floor.

DIRECTIONAL OR INFORMATIONAL SIGNS

- Characters and background are to be matte or non glare finish and contrast with each other.
- Characters can be upper and lower case and should be sized for viewing distance.
(Approximately 1" for every 50' of distance).
- Raised copy or Braille is not required for signs.

OVERHEAD SIGNAGE

- Characters and background are to be matte or non glare finish and contrast with each other.
- Characters are to be a minimum of 3" in height.
- Must be a minimum of 80" clearance between overhead sign and floor.
